

## Lonely Planet lists the world's top 10 cemeteries

WHITE PLAINS, N.Y. (AP) — A travel guide's list of the best places in the world to be entombed includes a New York suburban cemetery — for animals.

Lonely Planet's Best in Travel 2009 includes the Hartsdale Pet Cemetery with the Taj Mahal and the Great Pyramids among the 10 "best places of rest."

A spokesman for Hartsdale says it's "delighted to be in such esteemed company."

The guide says the headstones at the pet cemetery make fascinating reading. One says, "Sport: Born a dog, died a gentleman."

There are 70,000 creatures and several bereaved humans in the 112-year-old pet cemetery, which is 20 miles north of New York City in White Plains, a city in Westchester County.
